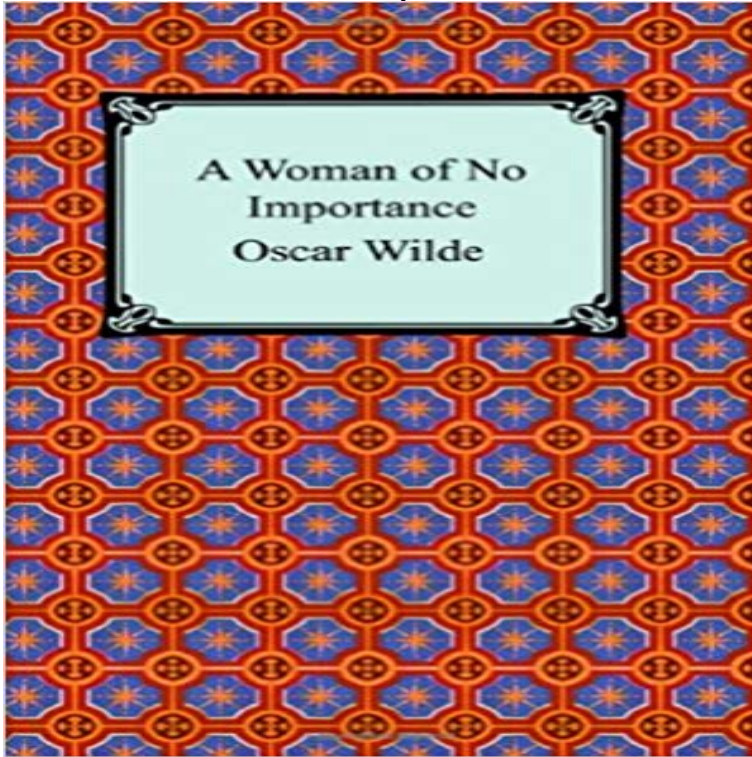


A Woman of No Importance
