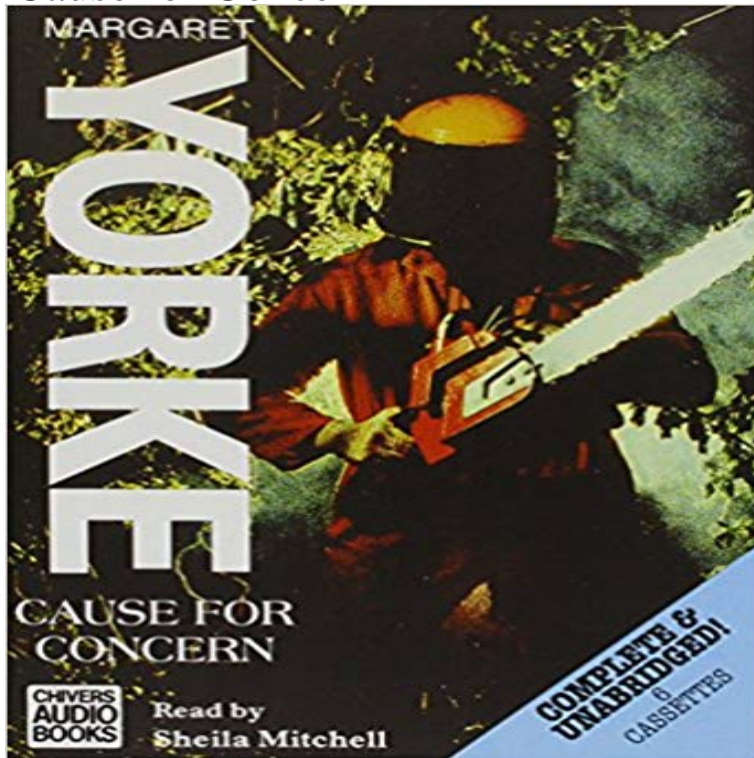


Cause for Concern
