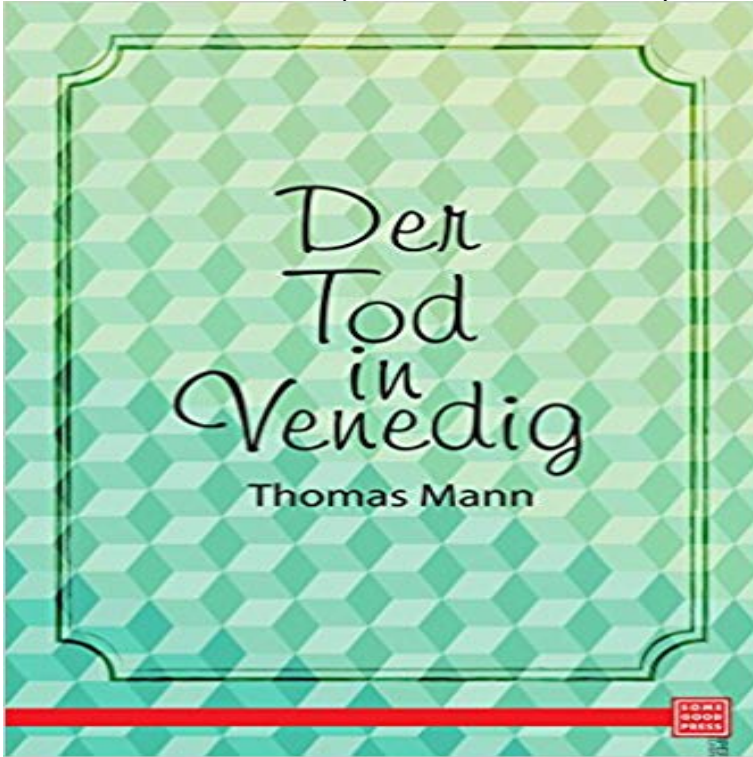


Death in Venice (German Edition)
