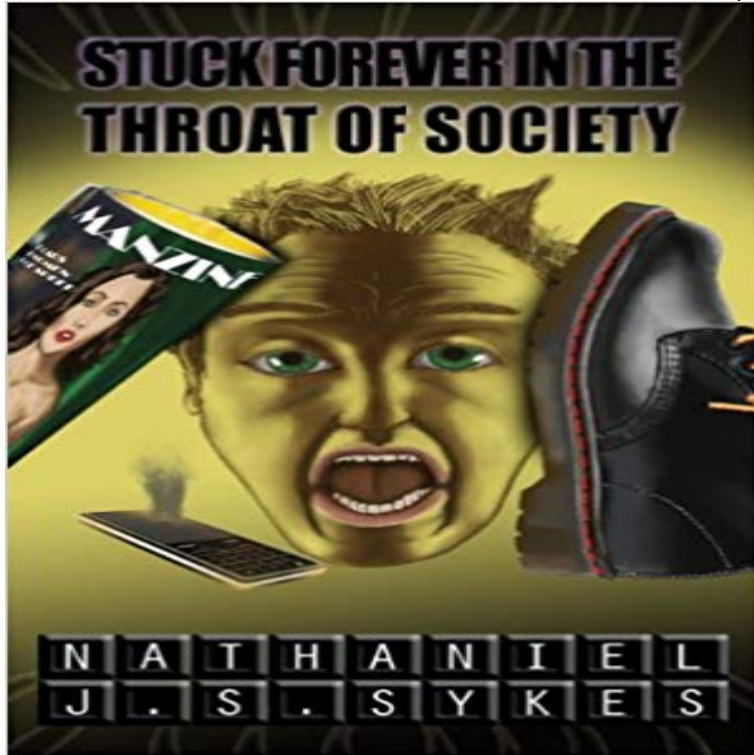


Stuck Forever in the Throat of Society
