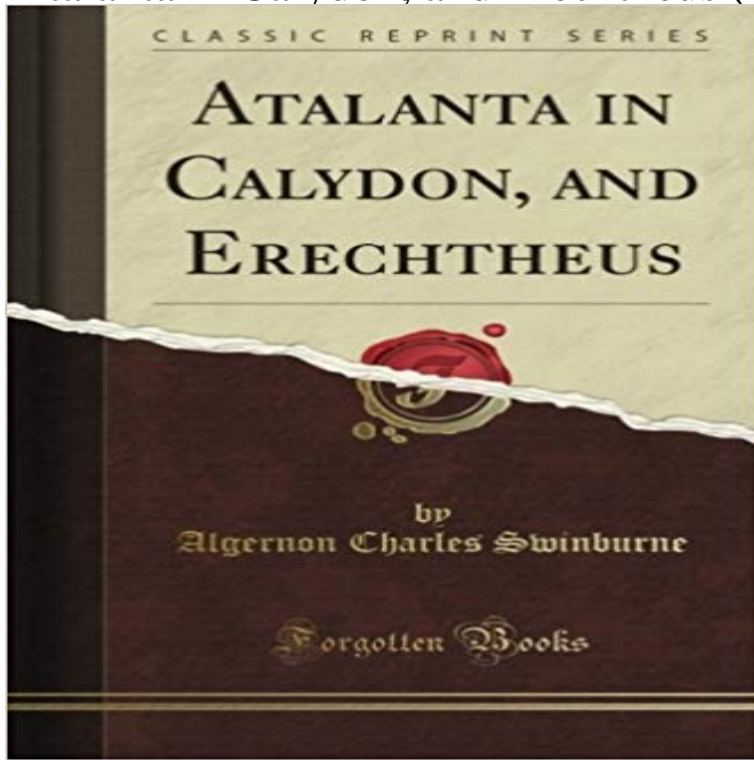


Atalanta in Calydon, and Erechtheus (Classic Reprint)
