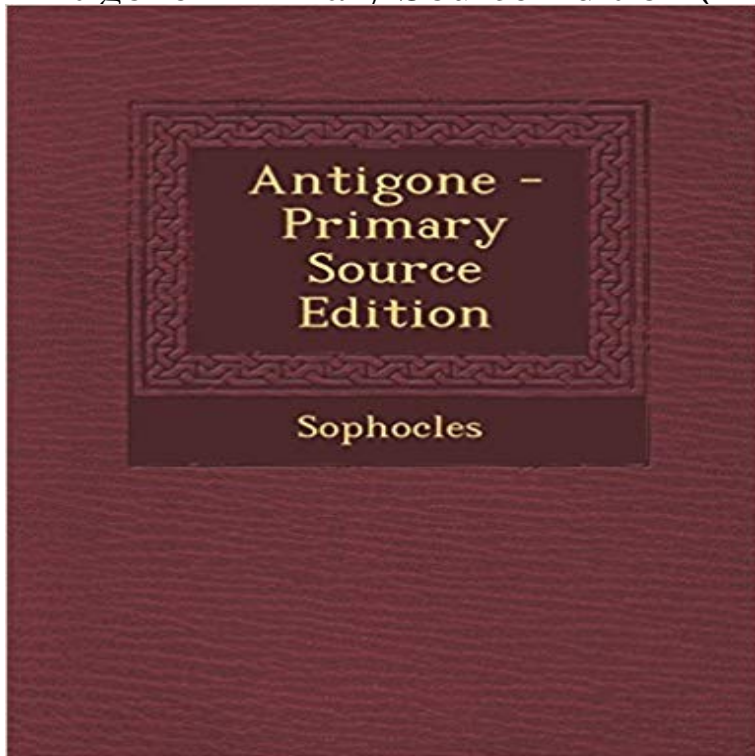


Antigone - Primary Source Edition (Ancient Greek Edition)
