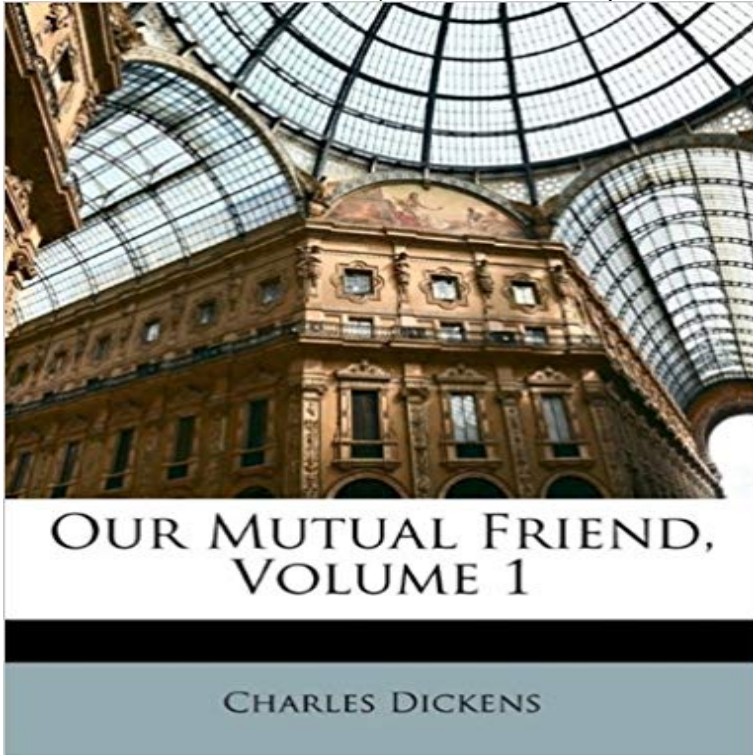


Our Mutual Friend, Volume 1 (Scots Edition)
